## LINCOLN PARK GARDENS AT BLESSED HOPE REGISTRATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Lincoln Park Gardens at Blessed Hope is a cooperative natural garden effort between the City, Lincoln Park Farmers' Market and Blessed Hope. The garden plots are available to Lincoln Park residents and church members on a first-come, first-serve basis. The goal is to help promote ease of obtaining healthy food choices through growing vegetables and offering learning opportunities in food preparation and preservation.

The garden will be laid out in 3-foot wide rows, with 3-foot aisles to facilitate planting, watering and weeding. Plots are allotted in 3-foot increments, with a maximum of 8 plots per person or 72 square feet maximum. A deposit of \$10 is required for 4 or more plots. The deposit will be returned at the end of the growing season. The garden is predominantly for vegetables, though flowers like marigolds may be used as a natural pest control. No chemical fertilizer or weed killer may be sprayed on the plots.

The form is attached and must be fully completed by you or your representative.

Submitting a registration form does not guarantee a plot. Plots are assigned on a first-come, first served basis. A waiting list will be kept. You will be contacted upon receipt of your form with information as to garden rules, etc. Your standing will be determined by April 18, 2015. Your final decision on participating must be communicated to us by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
